

Cost management is the bedrock of a successful project, more so now than ever, as markets come under pressure as economies change.

As project cost controlling activities are based on the output of project planning, tender evaluation, and estimates, the entire process of cost management aims to ensure that there is cost accountability, management, and value for capital investment. Therefore, cost controlling is vital for any construction project around the world.

The major factors associated with project delays are the contractor's influence and financial management. Cost overruns are very common wherever project delays occur. The major factors identified for cost and time overruns are risk factors regarding financial and political influence, the cost of construction materials, design changes, inaccurate estimations of time and cost, project complexity, lack of training on the part of the project manager, difficulty in collecting cost data and the cost of conducting cost control.



The techniques used by cost and project managers for cost control during construction are very important in determining if the project will complete on time and within budget.

Start the Relationship Early



The most critical decisions relating to the development of a project are made at the early stages when only limited information is available.

Review of traditional tender documents & Bills of Quantities (BQ's) for accuracy.

Irrespective of the type of contract, we offer a derisking service that allows the contractor / subcontractor to submit his tender with confidence in the knowledge that the tender documents have been thoroughly reviewed and risk identified. To do so C-QUEST will: Conduct a high-level review of the quantities within any set of tender documents for verification.

- Review the RFP and tender documents for risks and the proposed Agreement for contentious clauses
- Review the tender drawing quality for CAD and BIM models undertaking a "Fit for Purpose" analysis that will highlight faults and gaps within the proposed contract drawings and specifications
- Should Value Engineering or Sustainability cost analysis be a requirement, C-QUEST has those services available within our team and will offer a separate proposal for inexpensive production of any RFP requirement



Prepare BQ's for D&B tenders.

Design and Build (D&B) tenders offer alternative and greater risk, so in addition to the above services C-QUEST will:

- Conduct a detailed measurement of quantities to provide either a schedule of quantities or detailed POMI BQ, contingent upon the level of information available or the requirements of the RFP
- Review risks and offer a "Fit for Purpose" analysis of drawings as described in Item 1

The execution phase of a construction project relies on post-contract cost controlling techniques, such as cash flow monitoring, interim valuations, final account preparation, monitoring activities, complying with contract terms and responding in a timely manner, site meetings, and documentation of activities on site. These techniques are imperative for project success.

Our post-contract services aim to reduce the contractors overhead by the provision of service that controls the client/engineer and their site team from imposing their perception of the contract (and its risks) upon the contractor. This service is offered as either a separate stand-alone package or as a continuation of the proposed pre-contract services for a separate fee. The off-site service is available for the contract duration, although individual services are available upon request.




